



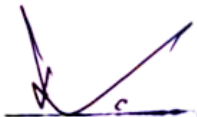



5th Regional Science and Technology Congress, 2022: a *Two-day* Program, to be organized preferably within December, 2022

Role of the Host Institute

To organize the entire program at the Regional level from receiving the Abstracts from the young researchers/scientists to the selection of the outstanding papers in each discipline with the fund support and structural guidance of the Department of Science and Technology and Biotechnology, Govt. of West Bengal.

Details of the Activities to be taken by the Host Institute

1. Selection of the Nodal Officer:

- i. The Name, Designation, Mobile no, & Email Id of the Nodal Officer of the Host Institute is to be communicated to this end for effective coordination and smooth organization of the program.
- ii. He will shoulder the responsibilities of the Organising Secretary jointly with the concerned Nodal Officer of the Department.
- iii. He will submit the activity calendar of the entire program within **28th September, 2022**, in consultation with the concerned Nodal Officer of the Department.

2. Scientific Disciplines on which the papers are to be Presented:

- I. Agriculture-Fisheries and Animal Science
- II. Botany
- III. Chemistry
- IV. Earth Sciences
- V. Engineering
- VI. Environmental Science
- VII. Mathematics
- VIII. Medical Science
- IX. Physics
- X. Physiology
- XI. Social Sciences and IPR
- XII. Zoology

3. Submission of Abstracts:

- i. Online Registration is to be done by the intending candidates for submission of abstract on any of the twelve disciplines within **31st October, 2022** through the Vigyan Chetana portal. (<https://dstbt.bangla.gov.in/vigyanchetana/>)
- ii. Normally, a researcher has to submit the abstract to that region where his Research Institute is located. He may submit a paper on multiple disciplines/more than one paper in the same discipline in the same region. But, he will not be allowed to submit papers in two different regions. If detected, his candidature will be cancelled.

4. Evaluation of Abstracts:

- i. Online evaluation of the Abstracts is to be done by the Experts/ Evaluators, to be selected by the Host Institute. **Two Experts/ Evaluators** are to be selected for each discipline within **28th September, 2022**, the list of which is to be shared with the Nodal Officer of the Department.
- ii. The evaluation of the Abstracts is to be completed within **10th November, 2022** through the website <https://dstbt.bangla.gov.in/vigyanchetana/>
- iii. Based on the merit of the Abstracts, generally **30 candidates** are to be selected from each discipline for oral presentation of the Papers on the D- day. In case of exemplary performances/ special instances, more than 30 candidates may be selected as per the discretion of the Evaluators.

5. Publication of the list of the shortlisted candidates:

- i. The lists of the selected candidates, indicating the date of presentation of paper are to be uploaded on the website of the Department viz. <https://dstbt.bangla.gov.in/vigyanchetana/> within **15th November, 2022** besides the website of the host institute.
- ii. The short-listed candidates are also to be intimated through email and SMS about their selection for the presentation of the papers at the RSTC within **15th, November 2022**
- iii. Guidelines for the participants regarding details of the paper presentation are also to be uploaded on both websites within **15th November, 2022**.

6. Printing of Abstracts

- i. The abstract volume containing the selected abstracts of all disciplines for presentation during the RSTC is to be printed by the Host Institute within **30th November, 2022**

- ii. PDF version of the selected Abstracts are to be uploaded on the website of the department besides the website of the Host Institute.

6.1 Scientific Model Competition for the College Students and above

- i. Applications are to be invited by the Host institute from the intending candidates mentioning the last date of submission of the application as **30th November, 2022**.
- ii. Application format is also to be divide by the Host Institute keeping parity with the application format for submission of Abstracts.
- iii. Maximum 30 Candidates will be allowed for physical demonstration of the Scientific Models on the D-Day, if required short listing is to be done depending on merits/topics. First 5 candidates will be awarded with cash prize and mementoes.
- iv. Adequate publicity is to be made thorough website of the respective institutes for wide dissemination and optimum participation of the potential students of the colleges and above.

7. Other preparatory arrangements for holding the RSTC:

7.1. Preparation of budget

- i. The host institute is to prepare a tentative budget estimate for organizing the entire program at the Regional level **within an amount of Rs. 15 lakhs (Rupees Fifteen lakhs only)** and to be submitted to the DSTBT within **28th September,2022**.
- ii. The budget estimate will include –
 - a) Cost of publicity b) Printing cost of Abstracts, Banners, Flexes, Posters, Invitation cards, I-cards, Certificates etc. c) Cost for Arrangement of Venue with Auditorium, 12 Sessions Halls etc. d) Fooding charges e) Transportation charges f) Accommodation charges(if any), g) Honorarium for the Abstract Evaluators, Session Judges, Speaker of the Memorial Lecture, Invited Lecture, Speakers of the Panel Discussion i) Cash prize for the presenter of the Outstanding Paper & Scientific Model j) Cost of Mementoes, etc.
- iii. Fixed amount –
 - Rate of honorarium for the Abstract Evaluator: Rs. 2000/-.
 - Rate of honorarium for the Session Judge: Rs. 2000/-.
 - Rate of honorarium for the Invited Speakers: Rs. 2000/-.
 - Rate of honorarium for the Memorial Lecture: Rs. 5000/-.
 - Rate of honorarium for the Speakers of the Panel Discussion: Rs. 2000/-.
 - Rate of honorarium for the Evaluators of the Scientific Models: Rs. 2000/-.
 - Rate of a Cash prize for the presenter of the Outstanding Paper: Rs. 3000/-.
 - Rate of a Cash prize for the presenter of the Outstanding Model: Rs. 2000/-.
 - Rate of memento for the Outstanding presenter: Rs. 1000/-.
- iv. The host Institute will share the Bank details for placement of fund.

7.2. Publicity of the program

- i. Invitations along with Information Brochure are to be sent through e-mail to all Universities, Institutes, Colleges, etc. lying within the comprising districts of the concerned region for wide publicity and larger participation of the potential candidates.
- ii. Besides, hard copy letters along with information Brochures and
- iii. The Host Institutes are to use their contacts for further publicity of the 5th Regional Science & Technology Congress, 2022.
- iv. District Information & Cultural Officer (DICO) of all comprising districts may be contacted for wider Publicity.

7.3. Printing of Posters/Banners/Flexes/Invitation Cards/I-Cards

- i. Adequate no.s of Banners, Flexes, Hoardings, Invitation Cards, I-Cards, etc. are to be printed for intensive publicity of the program.

Note: For printing of the publicity materials, the name of the Department of Science and Technology and Biotechnology, GoWB should be mentioned as the Joint Organizer of the program.

7.4. Selection of Judges and Speakers

Host Institute will select eminent scientists/researchers for the following purposes -

- Session Judges for evaluation of the Papers : 2 no.s for each discipline...total $12 \times 2 = 24$ no.s
- Invited Speakers: One for each discipline...total $12 \times 1 = 12$ no.s
- Speaker for the Memorial Lecture: One eminent personality from scientific background. Topic : to be decided by the Host Institute in consultation with the Speaker
- Speakers for the Panel Discussion: Maximum five no.s
- Evaluator of Scientific Models..2 no.s

Note: Topic for discussion will be selected by the host institute diligently and to be communicated to this end. **For Panel Discussion some burning issues of the concerned region may be selected which may be sorted out with scientific intervention.**

7.5. Arrangement of the Venue

- i. Auditorium of the host Institute is to be kept ready with an Audio system, Podium, Backdrop etc. for the Inaugural Program/Valedictory Session.
- ii. At least 12 Session Halls equipped with laptops, Projector, Screen, Audio systems etc. are to be arranged for the presentation of the papers by the short-listed candidates.
- ii. Arrangements for Scientific model competition.

- iii. Setting up of the Science Pavilion including Food Court and Registration arena.

7.6 Photography and Videography of the Program

- i. Still Photography and Videography are to be done for documentation of each event and to be shared with the Department.

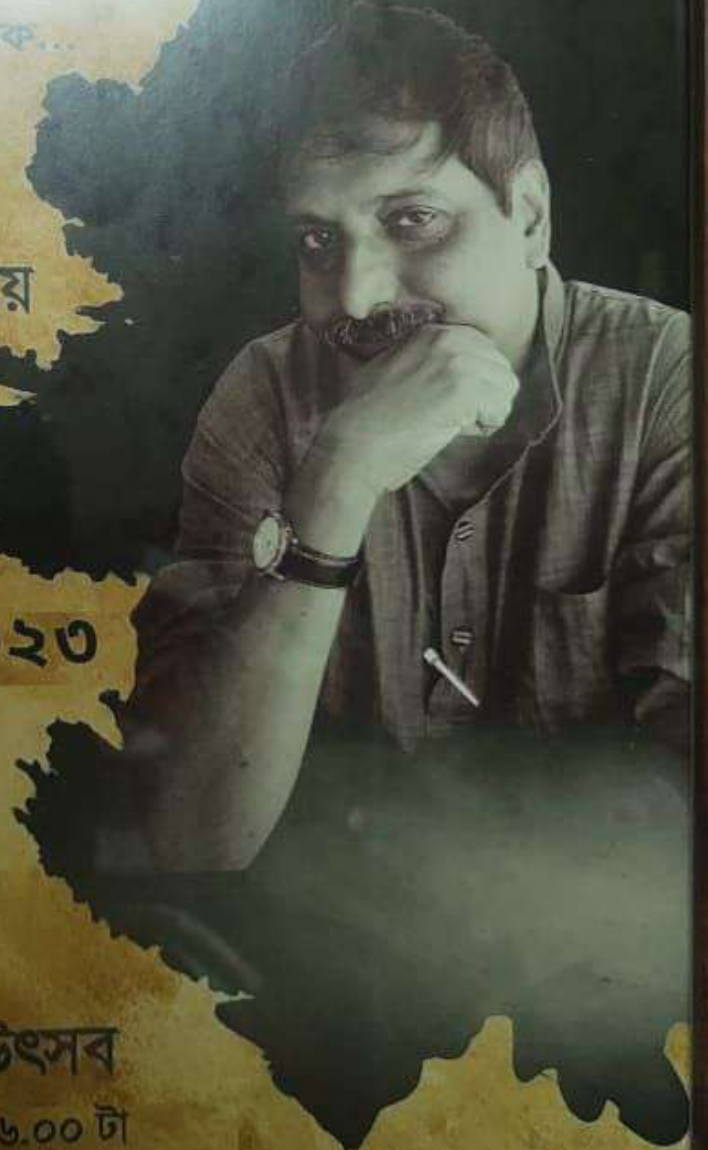
