Action Taken Report (ATR)

The following measures have been undertaken by the college authority to prevent and curb incidents of ragging on the college campus during the academic session 2025-26:

1. The college authority has constituted the Anti-Ragging Committee in accordance with the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions.
2. The college practices a zero-tolerance policy for ragging, which was reaffirmed at the beginning of the academic session 2025-26.
3. Awareness regarding and its consequences was spread through audio-visuals, print media, posters and pamphlets at conspicuous positions in the college.
4. The contact numbers of all the internal members of the Anti-Ragging Committee have been displayed at prime locations in the college campus to enable students and other stakeholders to contact them whenever necessary.
5. The Anti-Ragging Squad, comprising faculty members, non-teaching staff, student representatives, and external members, has been constituted. The details of the Squad are displayed on the college website.
6. CCTV cameras have been installed in the college campus including the students' canteen, corridor, main gate, common room and college backyard for proper surveillance of any inappropriate activities and ensure effective surveillance.
7. CCTV cameras have also been installed in the boy's and girl's hostel to record any untoward incidents and ensuring prompt action against any misconduct.

8. Posters promoting a ragging-free campus and highlighting issues related to ragging have been displayed in different parts of the college campus.
9. An interactive session on "Psychological Impact of Ragging on Students and Stress Management" was successfully organized on 17.07.2025 where students could discuss several issues with the resource person, Ms. Ipsita Banik, Clinical and Rehabilitation Psychologist.
10. The college mandated the submission of anti-ragging declarations on the National Anti-Ragging Portal (displayed on the college website) and submitting the duly signed acknowledgement/receipt at the time of admission. This is also being followed for the upcoming academic session (2026-27).
11. Awareness programs conducted prior to the admission process of the Sem I students in various disciplines were meant to sensitize the senior students regarding ragging and its consequences.
12. During the Student Induction Programme held on 06.11.2025, an Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme and an orientation on the grievance redressal mechanism were conducted to sensitize newly admitted students under the NEP curriculum.
13. For the upcoming academic session (i.e., 2026-27) the induction programme for the newly admitted students will be conducted from 07.07.2026 to 11.07.2026. A special session on 'Anti-Ragging Sensitization' will be organized for them during this induction programme.
